


- 2005 Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act



- What is a Safety Statement ?
 - Written document specifying how health, safety and welfare will be managed
 - Cornerstone of effective health and safety management in any business type

FATAL INCIDENT STATISTICS

There were 53 fatal work-related incidents in Ireland in 2020

Of these, 40 involved worker victims and 13 involved non-worker victims. This is a an improvement since 1998, the year of the earliest available CSO Labour Force Survey working population data, when 61 workers and 12 non-workers died in work-related incidents. However, 53 fatal work-related incidents in 2020 is an increase on the 47 incidents in 2019. Figure 3.1 shows that the rate of fatal incidents to workers has fallen from 3.8 per 100,000 workers in 1998 (the first year for which CSO employment survey data is available) to 1.7 per 100,000 workers in 2020.

- Used across different sectors












Top 20 BeSMART.ie Completed Business Types – 77,465






Using BeSMART.ie Risk Assessment (Manual Handling Example)




Step 3 – Consultation – Key Strategy Goal
