CEO's Remarks



CALLANT AND OWNERSHAM

You are most welcome to Clontarf Castle today to mark the 30th Anniversary of our founding in 1993.

Thirty years ago, the Celtic Tiger had yet to roar, ledand was just energing from its elighties stump, but the combination of memberable of the Duropean single market, prudest economic management and a skilled workforce were about to bear fruit. It is easy, and sometimes necessary, to be critical of ireland's

concerning progress, as ISME frequently has been. But let us first point out the positives: We have turned from being the poor man of Europe to one if it is best performing economies, and emigration is now most usually a lifestyle choice rather than an economic imperative.

Ireland's long-run economic progress since post-independence contraction has been built on the creation of a vibrant, open, trading, non-protectional economy, welcoming of foreign direct investment. (SME in not critical of the FDI model, but as the bedrock of the link economy, we understand its limitations better than most.

process, show us the necessity to avoid placing all ineland's economic oggs in the FOI basket. Not alone would this be strategic folly, but it would be fixed disaster: while FOI contributes a huge (but failing) amount to the irish economy in corporation tax, the Net National Product contribution of the dismestic sector (a measure of in-your-wallet economic value) is 3.75 times greater than that of foreign multisationals.

CEO's Remarks



The emerging global picture for the 2002's and beyond in much less benign than the first two decades of this century, we see the remempence of global power blocks, deglobalization, potentially reduced international trade, and more assertive local anticonalization. While we recognise the sature of lettand as a trading economy, we must mature into a more resilient society domestically, capable of dealing with identifiable risks and international shocks as we have not done before.

On top of this, we see legislatures in Leinster House and in Brussels that seem helibent on levels of regulation not being contemplated anywhere else in the world.

Forget "challenging." The simple fact is that times are going to become more difficult for small business, especially those competing at the maritime edge of Europe and sharing a land border with a close, but non-EU member.
